Minutes
November 21, 2018

The November meeting was called to order at 7:30 pm by supervisor S. Pollack with the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

Board members present for the November 21, 2018 meeting were S. Pollack, B. Hain, P. Uecker, L. Plank, B. Shea, J. Lawler, and J. Mahoney.

The minutes of the October meeting were presented for review by J. Lawler. B. Hain made a motion to accept the minutes. P. Uecker second the motion; motion carried

B. Shea gave the treasurer report. The checking account book balance is at \$293,581.31 P. Uecker motion to accept the Treasurer Report as given. B. Hain second the motion; motion carried. P. Uecker made a motion to pay all bills present. L. Plank second the motion; motion carried.

Dick Anneke approached the board to discuss building a drive way back to his property in the Haverhill Subdivision. There is a plotted road, cart way, but it was not develop. The reason for the request is Mr. Anneke would like to sell the property. The cart way is public lands own by the township so he could not build a driveway. P. Uecker had a question regarding if this issue is under the Haverhill Subdivision Association, which it is not. The Board will discuss with TCPA if the Township can sell the property to Mr. Anneke and than he can construct the drive way to his property. Mr. Anneke seemed ok with this solution if we can legally sell the property.

John Kruessel approached the board to see if the Township can help with the Kraus who lost their home in a fire. The Board cannot dentate to the Kraus family but we maybe send out an email to a let the residence know where they can donate to help them out.

Mr. Kruessel also discussed the Board to send information out to the Haverhill residence about the proposal of swapping roads (48th Street) with Olmsted County. He wants the residence to be aware of what might happen and how it might affect them.

Deputy Pagel presented the Board with the township's sheriff's report. There were 67 calls last month. The sheriff calls included the following;
