J. Mahoney gave the board an update on the receipts received from FEMA and Olmsted County from the road fuel tax.

#### Sheriff Report

Deputy Pagel presented the Board with the township's sheriff's report. There were 42 calls last month. The sheriff calls included the following;

  - 3 calls for assistance

The township was a little less active than the prior month. Deputy Pagel will be rotating out of her current position and Deputy Thompson will replace her as the Township Deputy Sheriff. The Board would like to thank Deputy Pagel for her service to the township.

4. Rochester School Board have reached out to the board it see if they can use the town hall for lunch pick up site for their students; no action taken
